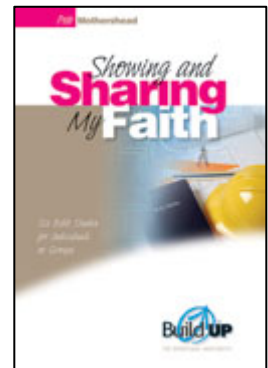
A Biblical View of Evangelism!
