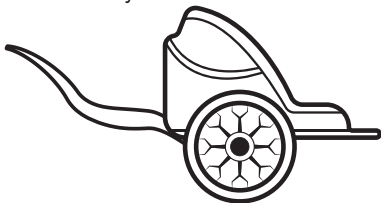
4 Judges 2:1–5.
