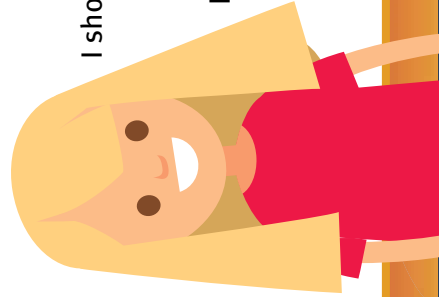

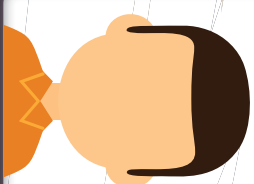

Read Proverbs 1:7.

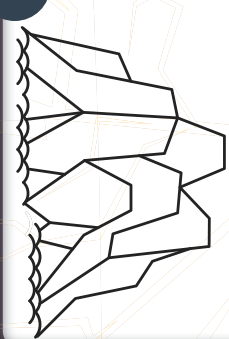
The person who hates God's wisdom is a fool. Fools think they can run their lives better than anyone, including God. All fools end up in trouble as they try to live apart from God.



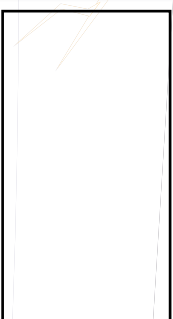

Moses set up a barrier to keep Israel from approaching their holy God without His permission. Make a sign telling Israel to stay away from God's holy presence on Sinai.



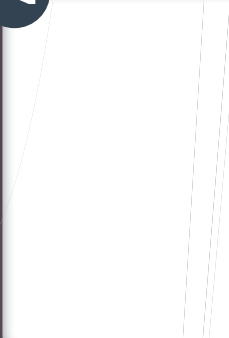
Jesus' death gives you access to God every day!
