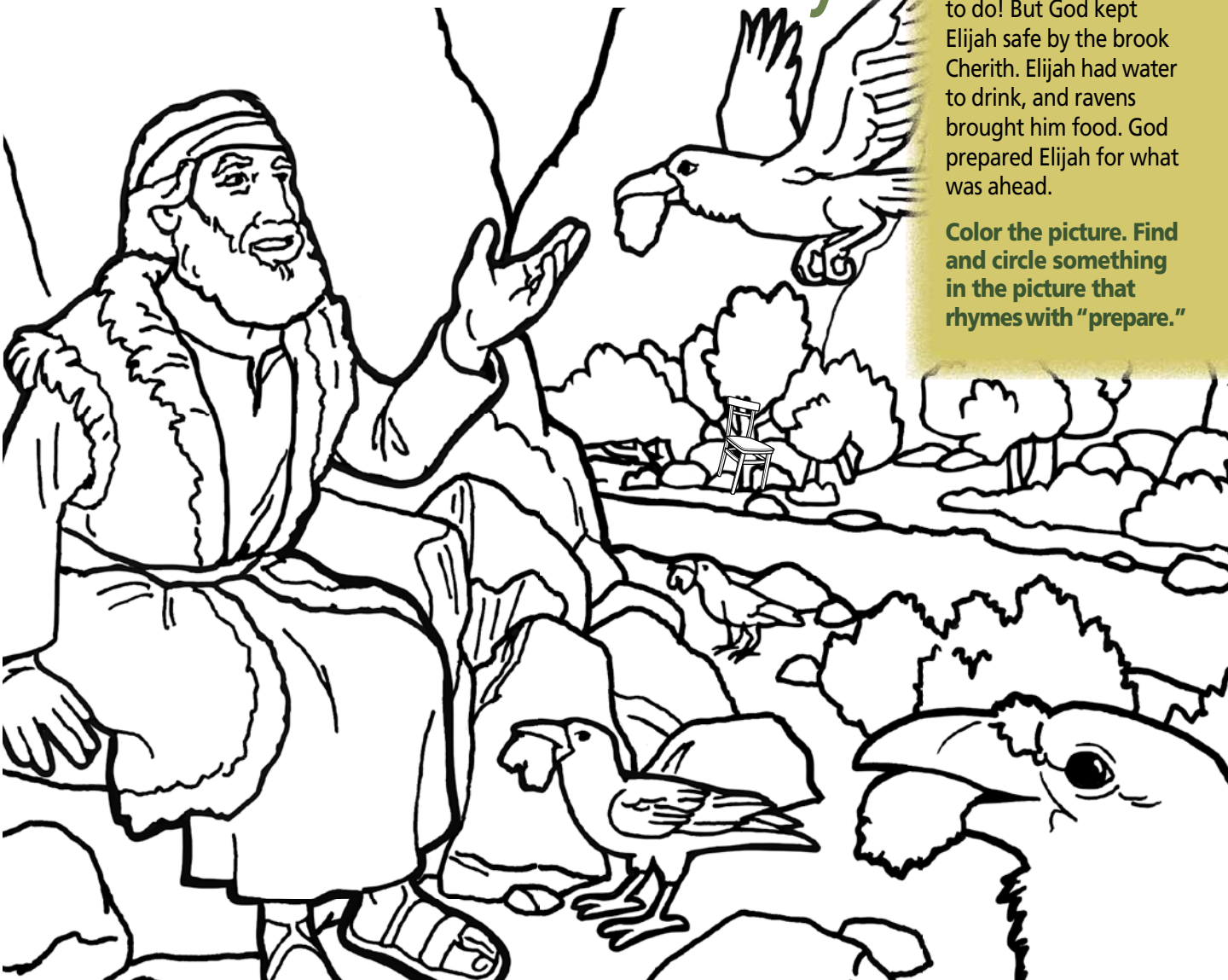

## Feathered Food Delivery

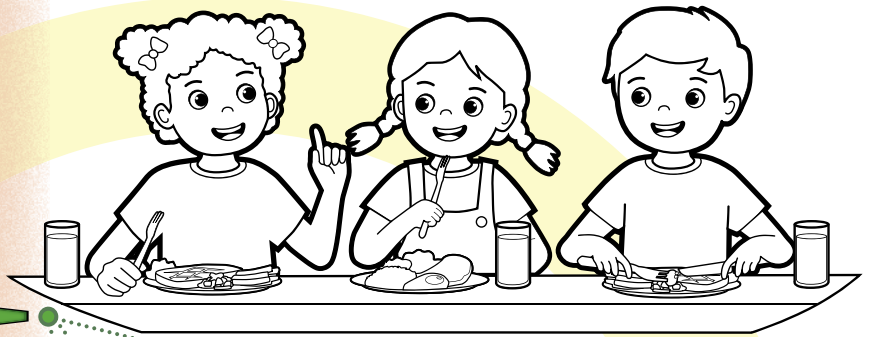

God cared about Elijah. He protected Elijah by hiding him at the brook Cherith, and He provided Elijah with food and water.

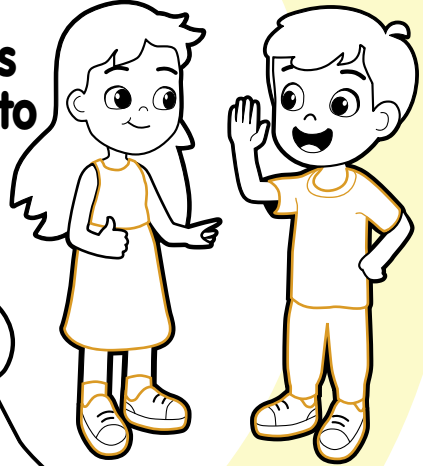


How might God take care of you? Color these pictures showing ways God could help you.
